OKATIBBEE

Lake near 342.48. Discharging 300 cfs.

BWT

Coffeeville- TW 3.7 ft this morning.

TENN-TOM

Fulton- 7.5 ft this morning. One gate open at Montgomery at 0.07 at this time.

ACT

Allatoona- Presently 838.1 and forecasted near 836.4 by end of next week.

Carters- Presently 1075.1 and forecasted near 1073 by end of next week. Generating 8,000 mwh with 7,800 mwh pump back (8 hours/day).

Claiborne- TW 13.7 ft this morning. Forecasted above 10 ft next week.

ACF

Buford- Presently 1069.95 and forecasted near 1069.3 by the end of next week.

West Point- Presently 633.1 and forecasted near 633.3 by the end of next week.

George- Presently 188.9 and forecasted near 188.75 by the end of next week.

Woodruff- Presently 76.97 lake & 43.7 tailwater. Lake forecasted near 77.1 ft by end of next week. Discharging 12,500 cfs. Discharges will gradually be lowered to 9,000 cfs.

Blountstown- Stage was 6.75 ft. Stage forecasted near 4 feet.

WEATHER & GENERAL INFO

Weather- Locally the weather will turn cold and windy Thur night and Fri, with highs in the 60's and lows in the 40's. Light rain possible in extreme N Ga and Extreme N. AL. as the cold air

moves through. Fall weather should continue throughout the district. With the cooler conditions, there should not be any more threats from tropical systems.
