PASCAGOULA

Okatibbee- 6 AM pool near 341.07ft. Discharging 30 cfs. Forecast near 340.9 next week.

BWT

Coffeeville- 6 AM tailwater near 2.36 ft. Two gates open 0.5'/One gate open 1.5'. (-1.0 ft is required on the Coffeeville lower gage for a 9-foot channel.)

TENN-TOM

Fulton- 6 AM stage near 7.50 ft. No gates open.

ACT

Allatoona- 6 AM pool near 839.97 ft. Forecast near 839.7 next week.

Carters- 6 AM pool near 1073.5 ft. Forecast near 1072.6 next week.

R. F. Henry- 6 AM pool near 125.4 ft. Forecast near 125.0 next week.

Millers Ferry- 6 AM pool near 80.5 ft. Forecast near 80.6 next week.

Claiborne- 6 AM tailwater near 8.9 ft. Forecast to be in range of 8-10 ft next week. 13.0 ft tailwater at the Claiborne gage is required for a 9-foot channel.

ACF

Buford- 6 AM pool near 1070.9 ft. Forecast near 1070.4 next week.

West Point- 6 AM pool near 634.6 ft. Forecast near 634.1 next week.

George- 6 AM pool near 189.1 ft. Forecast near 189.5 next week.

Woodruff- 6 AM pool near 76.9 ft with a tailwater near 42.03 ft. Pool forecast near 76.8 ft next week. Discharging near 9,800 cfs today.

Blountstown- 6 AM stage near 4.33 ft this morning. Forecast to be in the 4-5 ft range next week. A 9 ft stage provides a 9 ft channel depth.

WEATHER

Over the next two weeks we will see the typical mid-summer pattern of very little rainfall over the Mobile District with an occasional afternoon thunderstorm being the exception.

Temperatures in the region will range from the upper 80's to mid 90's over the next two weeks.
